Now in its fifteenth year, the International Sinan Symposium will explore the transformative role of design disciplines in today's world. The theme, 'Architecture & Transformation: New Possibilities, New Realities', aims to demonstrate that design fields such as architecture, interior design, and landscape architecture are **active agents in social, ecological, and digital transformations**, not merely formal production.

Mimar Sinan's intuitive and holistic architectural approach, which “transcended his era”, provides an inspiring foundation for reconsidering the transformative potential of design in the present day. **Design is no longer just an activity that shapes objects or spaces; it is a way of acting that changes relationships, processes and meanings.** It is anticipated that the symposium will **generate new possibilities** by opening a discussion on the transformative power of design in both the physical and intellectual realms.

The aim of this symposium is to explore the multifaceted, transformative power of design. We will adopt a broad perspective, spanning **technological innovations, social transformations, ecological resilience and cultural production**. Design is a way of thinking that, alongside the dissolution of disciplinary boundaries, is giving rise to **new collaborations and hybrid fields of production** within design practices.

The fifteenth anniversary of the symposium also enables us to consider these discussions as marking an **intellectual threshold** between the legacy of the past and the possibilities of the future. Mimar Sinan's creativity, which transcends time, serves as a metaphor for re-examining the ‘transformative power of design’ within a historical continuum. The “new realities” created by design are being redefined in every aspect of daily life, not only in digital environments. In the face of ecological crises, migration, social fractures and technological revolutions, the production of space is taking on new meanings.

In this context, the 15th International Sinan Symposium invites you, our esteemed scholars, to discuss the new possibilities and realities created by design transformation through interdisciplinary dialogue. We also encourage you to reflect on, research and share your insights regarding transformation.

Sub-theme headings:

Spatial Transformation and Social Impact: Discussing design's multi-layered transformative power, spanning from individual lifestyles to public spaces, through the concepts of social relations, a sense of belonging, and spatial justice.

Digital Transformation and New Spatial Realities: Examining the transformations brought about by digital tools, such as artificial intelligence, virtual environments, and data-driven design, in design practice.

Ecological Transformation and Sustainable Futures: To explore design's potential to drive environmental change in the context of the climate crisis, energy efficiency, circular design, and the integration of space with nature.

Disciplinary Transformation and the Blurring of Boundaries: Evaluating hybrid design practices, new forms of representation and models of collaboration arising from the dissolution of boundaries between different design disciplines.

Cultural Transformation and the Reconstruction of Heritage: Reinterpreting historical layers through contemporary design tools; examining the transformative relationship between conservation, adaptation, and identity production.

Pedagogical Transformation and New Paradigms in Design Education: Discussing the transformations that design education is undergoing in terms of form, content, and method within a changing social and technological context.

Aesthetic Transformation and Sensory Experience: Examining transformations in the sensory, psychological, and perceptual dimensions of design, and addressing how space is experienced.

Ethical Transformation and a Culture of Responsible Design: Rethinking the ethical responsibilities that accompany the transformative power of design with a focus on justice, inclusivity, and sustainability.
